Description of job roles under PCP	<p>Nursing is an exciting and fulfilling career, encompassing autonomous and collaborative care of individuals of all ages, families, groups and communities, sick or well in all settings. Nursing includes the promotion of health, prevention of illness, and the care of ill, disabled and dying people. Advocacy, promotion of a safe environment, research, participation in shaping health policy and in patient and health systems management, and education are also key nursing roles. Registered nurses will perform direct nursing care, assist with medical procedures and monitor patients' progress. Funding support and estimated PCP monthly training allowance	<p>Course fees will be fully sponsored. There will be funding support by WSG, the Ministry of Health (MOH) and a co-sponsoring organisation for trainees to undergo the two-year Bachelor of Science (Nursing) programme at the National University of Singapore.</p> <p>Trainees will receive training allowances ranging from \$2,170 to \$2,520 per month, pegged to their years of prior work experience, throughout the two-year training period. PCP selection criteria	<p>General PCP eligibility criteria: The candidate should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Be a Singapore Citizen or Singapore Permanent Resident; ○ Have graduated or completed National Service for at least 2 years, whichever is most recent <p>Other Entry Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Bachelor degree from a recognised university in a discipline other than nursing; <u>and</u> ○ Local polytechnic diploma in a science-related field in a discipline other than nursing <u>or</u> ○ Any two H2 or 'A' level passes* in Biology, Chemistry, Computing, Physics and Mathematics <p>*H2 or GCE 'A' level passes refer to grades A to E.</p> <p>Meeting the above requirements does not guarantee enrolment onto the PCP. Admission is based on a holistic assessment of the candidate and subject to other requirements, including clearing the medical test and securing sponsorship from a participating organisation.</p>
Description of training	<p>Selected candidates will undergo a two-year full-time programme conducted at the National University of Singapore (NUS), comprising on-campus training and clinical attachments in different hospital care settings. Upon successful completion the programme, graduates will be awarded with a Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing. They will be eligible for registration with Singapore Nursing Board and obtain a license to practise as a Registered Nurse.</p>

Application window	<p>Applications open around January each year. Class commences in early August each year.</p>
